

RESOLUTION NO. 385-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON, declaring the 1971 Ford F900 fire pumper truck surplus to the needs of the Town, and authorizing the sale thereof by sealed bid.

WHEREAS, the Town owns a yellow 1971 Ford F900 fire pumper truck bearing VIN #F90LVL-71568; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that this vehicle is no longer used for municipal purposes, nor is there any plan to use it for any municipal purpose within the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it would be in the best interests of the Town to sell the vehicle to the highest bidder by sealed bid, with an undisclosed reserve to be fixed by the Mayor after discussions with the Town Council, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Farmington that:

- A. The above described vehicle is surplus to the needs of the Town.
- B. The vehicle shall be sold by sealed bid. All bids must be received by the Town Clerk at Farmington Town Hall located at 203 Main Street, P.O. Box 65, Farmington, WA, 99128, on or before 3:00 p.m. on November 20, 2017.
- C. A notice of sale shall be posted within the Town at the usual places where public notices are posted, and it shall be published at least once not sooner than ten days before the sale in the Town's official newspaper, together with other newspapers, if any, as the Town Clerk may determine reasonable and appropriate.
- D. Prior to the sale, the Mayor shall fix a reserve price (minimum bid) after discussion with the Town Council. The reserve shall be disclosed to the Council, but shall remain confidential and undisclosed to the public until the auction is concluded.
- E. The vehicle shall be conveyed to the highest bidder upon payment of the full bid amount in cash, cashier's check, or certified bank check no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 27, 2017. If the high bidder fails to pay the full bid amount as required, the property shall immediately be offered to the next highest bidder for the same amount as the highest bid. If the next highest bidder shall decline

the offer and/or fail to pay the full bid amount within two (2) hours after being offered the property, the sale shall cancel.

- F. The buyer shall be responsible for all fees associated with transferring title to the vehicle, including excise tax.
- G. The vehicle shall be sold "as is" without any warranties as to its condition or its suitability for the buyer's intended use.
