Approval of the March Treasurer's Report:

Jaime Lopez **moved** for approval of the March 2019 Treasurers Report showing Farmington with a cash balance of \$257,482.92. \$167,505.48 in checking and \$89,977.44 in the MMDA account. Diana Oliver seconded the motion, the motion passed.

DLD BUSINESS:

• At Mayor Baker's request Volunteer Fire Chief/Councilmember Brian Oliver represented Farmington at the Fire District #10 Commissioner's meeting in order to explore the best option for Farmington regarding fire protection, whether that be a merger or a contract for services. Brian reiterated that the enthusiasm for the RFA has dwindled dramatically and it does not appear as though an RFA will be formed within Whitman County. Farmington Town Council will need to decide what type of an agreement they want to enter into with Fire District #10 for fire protection. According to Brian the most practical agreement would be for Farmington to enter into a contract with District #10 – wherein the Town would relinquish ownership of their pumper truck and their portion of ownership of the fire department building located in Farmington. The Town of Farmington will also be required to pay a yearly fee to Fire District #10 – the sum of which has not yet been determined, however it is speculated that the fee will be in the neighborhood of \$4,700 per year. Brian will be meeting with Fire District #10 Commissioners later this week to obtain actual specifics regarding a District #10/Farmington contract.

NEW BUSINESS:

Jaime Lopez motioned to approve Resolution 392-19 Excess Levies to be placed on the 2019 Primary Election Ballot, Brian
 Oliver seconded the motion, the motion passed.

PROPOSITION NO 1

The Town Council of the Town of Farmington adopted Resolution 392-19, concerning a proposition to finance street maintenance and repair and street improvements for the Town of Farmington. This proposition would authorize the town to collect an excess property tax levy upon all taxable property within the town in the amount of \$8,000.00, an estimated \$1.64 or less per \$1,000.00 of assessed value in the year 2019 for collection in 2020. - Cody Lord is assisting with Farmington's annual report and stated that the Town's financials look great and that budget numbers are right on target for the beginning of 2019's 2nd quarter.

- The Mayor also informed the Council that he purchased and had installed two new batteries on the Town's John Deere tractor.
