EXCESS LEVIES – PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON WASHINGTON, to place propositions on the November 3, 2020, General Election Ballot, to be voted on by the voters of the Town of Farmington.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Farmington that the Whitman County Auditor is requested to place the following proposition on the November 3, 2020, General Election Ballot, to be voted upon by the voters of the Town of Farmington:

PROPOSITION NO 1

The Town Council of the Town of Farmington adopted Resolution 397-20, concerning a proposition to finance street maintenance and repair and street improvements for the Town of Farmington. This proposition would authorize the town to collect an excess property tax levy upon all taxable property within the town in the amount of \$8,000.00, an estimated \$1.57 or less per \$1,000.00 of assessed value in the year 2020 for collection in 2021.
