Roadway Dust Control:

Mayor Dugan presented the Council with the quoted prices for dust control from both Lyman's and Mort's. Instead of contracting for dust control at this time, the council was in agreement that the streets need to be graded, re-crowned, ditches pulled and additional gravel applied before any dust control material could be of benefit to the roadways. The council unanimously agreed to spend up to \$5000.00 to have Whitman County Public Works grade 5th Street from Washington Street to Bridge Street and Bridge Street, East Main Street, Chestnut Street and Pine Street between 3rd & 5th. Any remaining funds are to be spent to have Gene Rambo of Rambo Trucking apply gravel to the above mentioned streets.
