

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON
RESOLUTION # 251-00
WATER/SEWER RATE RAISE**

WHEREAS: IT IS REQUIRED THAT THE WATER AND SEWER RATES BE RAISED TO COVER THE RISING COST OF EXPENSES.

WHEREAS: IT HAS BEEN PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AT THE REGULAR MEETING HELD AT CITY HALL APRIL 10, 2000.

NOW THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

The residential water rates be raised by \$3.00 from \$16.50 to \$19.50 per 1000 cubic feet or 7500 gallons flat rate, and \$.75 for each 500 cubic feet or 3750 gallons thereafter.

The residential sewer rates be raised by \$5.00 from \$16.50 to \$21.50 flat rate.

The commercial water rates be raised by the same amount as residential rates of \$3.00 from \$31.00 to \$34.00 flat rate.

Stand-by charges will be raised by the same amount as residential and commercial water and residential sewer. Therefore, the rate will be raised from \$10.00 to \$13.00 for water and \$10.50 to \$15.50 for ~~water~~^{of sewer}, for a total of \$28.50 for water/sewer residential stand-by.

THE NEW RATES WILL GO INTO EFFECT MAY 1, 2000 WITH THE FIRST COLLECTION ON THAT DATE.

THIS RESOLUTION #251-00 WAS PASSED AND SIGNED INTO EFFECT ON THIS DATE, APRIL 10, 2000.
