

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON  
RESOLUTION #275-05  
WATER/SEWER RATE RAISE**

WHEREAS: It is required that the water and sewer rates be raised to cover the cost of rising expenses.

WHEREAS: It has been passed unanimously by the Town Council at the regular meeting held at City Hall February 14, 2005.

NOW THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

The residential water rates will be raised by \$3.00 from \$23.50 to \$26.50 per 1000 cubic feet or 7500 gallons flat rate and \$.75 for each 500 cubic feet or 3750 gallons thereafter.

The stand-by rates will therefore be raised by the same amount as residential. Therefore, the rate will be \$20.00 up \$3.00 from the old rate of \$17.00, for a meter showing no use and deemed to be on stand-by.


The commercial rates will go up accordingly from \$38.00 to \$41.00 flat rate.

The sewer rates will be raised by \$2.00 from \$21.50 to \$23.50 flat rate. Commercial rate is the same as residential.

THE NEW RATES WILL GO INTO EFFECT FEBRUARY 15, 2005 WITH THE FIRST COLLECTION DUE ON MARCH 1, 2005.

THIS RESOLUTION #275-05 WAS PASSED AND SIGNED INTO EFFECT ON THIS DATE FEBRUARY 14, 2005.
