
NOW THEREFORE: THE TOWN COUNCIL APPROVES THE SIX YEAR TRANSPORTATION PLAN AS FOLLOWS:

YEARS 2012 TO 2017

1. Reconstruction	Second - Washington to Chestnut	\$288,000
2. Reconstruction	Second - Chestnut to Alder – Phase 2	\$310,000
3. Reconstruction	Alder - Second to Third	\$160,000
4. Reconstruction	Bridge Street - Third to Fourth	\$120,000
5. Resurfacing Project	50% of all gravel road within the Town of Farmington	\$230,000
6. Resurfacing Project	50% of all gravel roads within the Town of Farmington – Phase 2	\$230,000
7. Paving Project	Resurface gravel road with asphalt 5 th Street - Washington to Pine	\$ 60,000
8. Resurfacing Project	Patch and overlay existing asphalt Washington to Main	\$ 25,000
9. Replacement Project	1 st Street Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Lincoln to Adams	\$100,000




