

ORDINANCE NO. 244-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON, amending the legal descriptions of Ordinance Nos. 236-17, 238-17, 239-17, and 240-17.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2017, the Town of Farmington passed Ordinance Nos. 236-17-238-17-239-17, and 240-17 thereby vacating certain streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the legal description contained in such ordinances incorrectly referred to a "Traux Addition" to the Town of Farmington; and

WHEREAS, the Town has determined that a "Traux Addition" to the Town of Farmington does not exist, and should instead refer to "Original Town of Farmington;" and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to correct the legal descriptions in such ordinances by replacing "Traux Addition" with "Original Town of Farmington," now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Farmington as follows:

Section 1. The legal description of the vacated alley in Ordinance No. 236-17 is hereby amended as follows: the alley lying between Lots 1-8, Block 10, Original Town of Farmington.

Section 2. The legal description of the vacated alley in Ordinance 238-17 is hereby amended as follows: The alley lying between Lots 1-8, Block 41, Original Town of Farmington.


Section 3. The legal description of the vacated portion of Alder Street in Ordinance No. 239-17 is hereby amended as follows: That portion of Alder Street between Church Street and Pine Street lying between Lots 1-4, Block 10, and Lots 1-4, Block 48, Original Town of Farmington.

Section 4. The legal description of the vacated portion of Church Street in Ordinance 240-17 is hereby amended as follows: That portion of Church Street between Bridge Street and Alder Street lying between Lots 5-8, Block 41, Original Town of Farmington and Lots 1-4, Block 48, Original Town of Farmington.

Section 5. Except as revised by this ordinance, Ordinance Nos. 236-17, 238-17, 239-17, and 240-17 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law, and upon the filing of a certified copy with the Auditor of Whitman County, Washington.
