Approval of the January Treasurer's Report:

Brian Oliver **moved** for approval of the January 2019 Treasurers Report showing Farmington with a cash balance of **\$253,982.76**. **\$164,034.40** in checking and **\$89,948.36** in the MMDA account. Jaime Lopez **seconded the motion, the motion passed.**

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mayor Pro-tem Hellinger confirmed with the council that they had each received a copy of the email correspondence between he and the manager of the Main Street program (including the application for membership). The director of the program stated that she does not have a model to compare Farmington with as the population of their smallest member is 1000 residents.

NEW BUSINESS:

- None.

Council Comments:

- None.

Clerk-Treasurer Comments:

- The Clerk asked the council for approval of a reimbursement check of \$250.00 to Barney Buckley for training, a payment of \$40.00 to Anatek Labs for testing and a check to KME for \$735.02, payment for troubleshooting the pump failure at the sewer lift station. Diana Oliver **moved** for approval of **\$1025.02** to cover the above expenditures which will show on the council's March meeting check register. Jaime Lopez **seconded the motion, the motion passed.**

Mayor's Comments:

- Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger advised the council that Mayor Baker has been unable to make any progress in regard to finding someone to lease the town's 4.5 acres of hay ground.
- Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger reported that Mayor Baker has hired the Town's sewer operator Barney Buckley to also function as the Town's water operator, and that Tim Hokenson has been hired to fill in as snow plow driver while Rudy Goossen recovers from wrist surgery.
- Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger asked the council for approval of a \$2070.60 proposal from KME for the purchase of a spare impeller and volute wear ring for the existing hydromantic lift pump at the lift station. Brian Oliver **moved** for approval of the expenditure, Jaime Lopez **seconded the motion, the motion passed.**
- Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger stated that he intends to research what, if any impact the new internet sales tax will have on the tax revenue of Washington Cities and Towns. He also stated that he will place a call to Frontier in regard to the Willow tree branches which rest upon Frontier's DSL lines near Bridge Street here in Farmington.
- Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger reported to the council that on Friday the 15th of February, following multiple days of snow accumulation, several of the branches from the fir trees which surround the community center were resting upon the power lines which provide power to the main transformer in town. Avista was called and responded and determined that the feed line was compromising the transformer thus causing a safety issue. Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger summoned Bill's Tree Service who removed the broken and compromised branches from the canopies of all 20 fir trees which surround the community center – thus alleviating the safety concern. Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger paid Bill's Tree service \$1617.00 for their services. Councilmembers Brian Oliver and Jaime Lopez asked that Mark be reimbursed for this expense and that the expenditure be ready for approval at their March meeting. Mayor Pro-Tem Hellinger stated that Bill from Bill's tree service felt that possibly two of the fir trees along Main Street were dead and should be removed this spring once confirmation can be made that they are indeed deceased.
- Brian Oliver stated that as Fire Chief he would like to purchase at least six Candle Stick Safety Cones as well as a few rolls of safety tape for use in situations similar to what occurred on Friday as described above. He asked if the council would consider paying for 50% of the expenditure (approximately \$150.00). Diana Oliver **moved** for approval of the expenditure, Jaime Lopez **seconded the motion, the motion passed.**
