Approval of the December Treasurer's Reports:

Diana Oliver moved for approval of the December 2018 Treasurers Report showing Farmington with a cash balance of \$270,291.26. \$180,358.18 in checking and \$89,933.08 in the MMDA account. Lavon Walser seconded the motion, the motion passed.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

Mark Hellinger advised the audience that he made contact with the Garfield City Clerk in regard to Garfield's LED speed signs. The clerk stated that Garfield is looking into upgrading their signs and if they do so, Farmington will be considered to receive their surplus signs which were purchased new for \$5000.00 with the use of AWC Safety Grant funds.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Brett Lisenbee presented the council with a proposal for the lease of 4.5 town owned acres of land in the Southeast quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 46 East, W.M., Whitman County. Washington known locally as the "Old Saw Mill Site". Mayor Baker said that prior to a decision being made, he needs time to see if anyone is interested in leasing the ground who would be willing to financially compensate the town for use of the ground.

## **Council Comments:**

Councilman Jaime Lopez questioned whether or not the town should consider selling its 4.5 acres of land in order to generate revenue rather than lease it out. Diana Oliver felt that it could be of value in a trade situation for future lagoon property and that it should possibly be held onto for such a use.

Councilman Mark Hellinger stated that he will check with SWEDA to ascertain the legalities and ramifications (good and bad) of having local businesses apply to have 75% of their B&O taxes returned or re-routed back to the local coffers. Mark stated that there are restrictions on the way the B&O taxes are to be spent and that a special account would need to be established by the town to receive the funds. Mark will report back to the council with more information on the subject.

Mayor's Comments:

Mayor Baker advised the council that Barney Buckley has agreed to take over the management of Farmington's water system at a cost to the town of \$30.00 per hour. Brian Oliver motioned to hire Barney Buckley at \$30.00 per hour to manage Farmington's water system, Mark Hellinger seconded the motion, the motion passed.

Mayor Baker asked the council to speak to town residents to see if there is a current need to have raccoon traps set, and if so to email a list of locations to the clerk so that the trapper can be advised.
