

ORDINANCE NO. 253-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON, establishing a general penalty for violating all ordinances within the Town.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

- A. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the Town shall be guilty of a civil infraction.
- B. Any person convicted of a civil infraction under any ordinance of the Town of Farmington shall be punishable as follows: \$125.00 for the first offense, \$250.00 for the second offense, and \$500.00 for the third offense.
- C. A person is guilty of a separate offense each and every day or portion of a day in which a violation of any provision of the ordinances of Farmington is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person, and any such person shall be punished accordingly.
